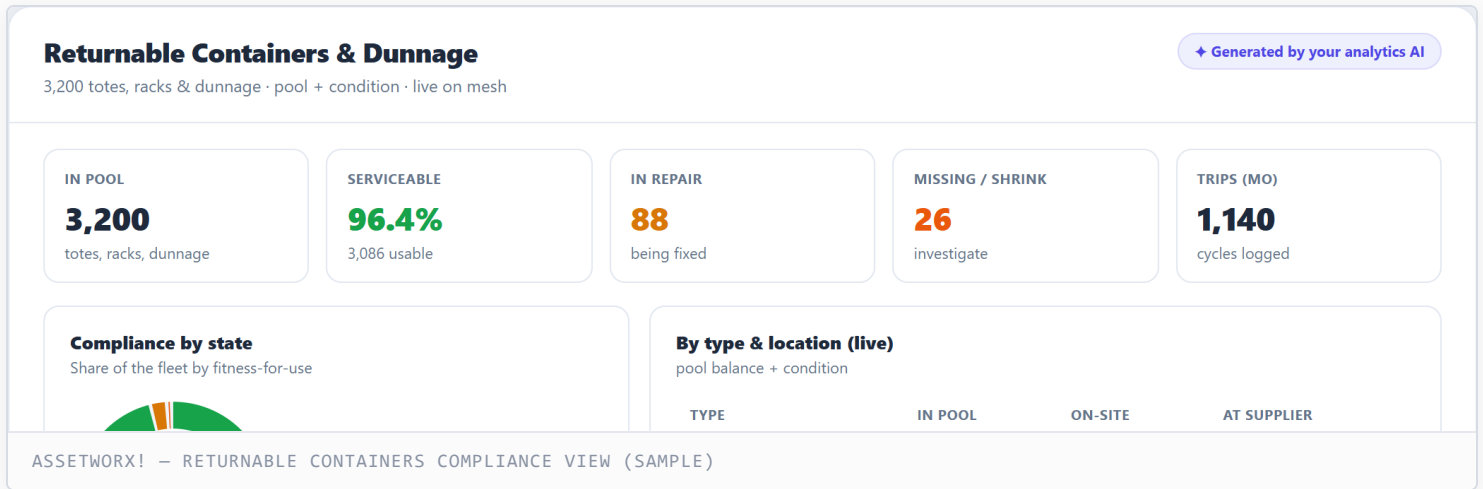


Returnable Containers

Pooled totes, IBCs and kegs tracked, inspected and returned.



A WHAT IT TRACKS

Returnable and pooled containers — totes, IBCs, racks and kegs — across owners and pool operators.

C INSPECTION CADENCE

- Return-condition inspection — risk-based
- Hazmat IBC periodic test — every 2.5 years (30 months)

B STANDARDS IT MAPS TO

Returnable-asset tracking policy

Internal policy for non-hazmat pooled assets

49 CFR 180.352

Applies when the container carries hazmat — IBC periodic retest (DOT)

D HOW IT WORKS — THE INFINID MECHANISM

- Two tags, cross-checked.** Every asset carries an active V-Tag plus a passive RFID tag, bound together in AssetWorx!. Each read reconciles the two — a mismatch flags tag-swap, tamper, or an uninspected item put back into service.
- Hands-free location.** The active V-Tag runs on a Zigbee self-healing mesh, reporting zone-level location that settles in about 3–4 minutes — tags report themselves, no scanning required.
- Intervals watched for you.** The platform tracks each inspection interval by time, use-cycles or hours, and fires pre-expiry alerts before anything falls out of date.
- Certificates & open data.** It generates the certificate / register of examination on demand, and feeds your ERP, reporting and AI through an open REST data contract.

KEY DATA CAPTURED Container type (tote / IBC / rack / keg), owner / pool operator, hazmat flag, last IBC-test date, capacity.
